Signage has arrived. Temporary signs will be placed on each door alerting public of date of the secure facility which is June 4, 2018.

Parking-city is working with County to move the handicap over to center by the middle sidewalk. Enforcement will increase.

New sidewalk is installed.

Public announcements will begin-suggestions were newsmakers, chamber newsletter, radio, newspapers.

Green suggested a quarterly drill for the PAGE system and a fire drill. Safety Committee is also recommending a fire drill take place.

Review of incidents-incident at Motor Vehicle-Kramer has not reviewed the video but will review and meet with office to review the incident. 911 was called. Panic buttons were not used.

Public Comments-Bob Peterson of North Platte discussed the misinformation that is out in the public and asked that the Committee do better at getting the accurate information out there. Guests present asked questions, and committee answered. There is a tab on the County Website where a Frequently Asked Questions document and Agenda and Minutes are posted. Committee will work on getting more information out for public to view. Committee thanked Bob for coming and informing the Committee of some of the misinformation.

Joe Wright reviewed the liability of the contract.
