

Security Committee
March 27, 2018

The meeting of the Security Committee was held on March 27, 2018 at 9:00 a.m. in the Commissioner's Room.

Henry called the meeting to order at 9:00 AM. Present were Bill Henry, Roland Kramer, Les Green, Tammy White, Booker Boyer. Absent was Jerome Kramer, Brandon Myers, Julie Stenger, and Michelle Gurciullo. Guests present were Jeff Higgins, Dave Pate, George Lewis, Dennis Thompson and Mike McConnell.

Henry announced the Open Meeting Act with amendments is posted for public review and the Security Committee will comply with the open meeting requirements.

Roland Kramer moved to approve the order of the Agenda. Green seconded. Roll Call Vote: Jerome Kramer-absent, Bill Henry-aye, Tammy White-aye, Julie Stenger-absent, Les Green-aye, Booker Boyer-aye, Michelle Gurciullo-absent, Roland Kramer-aye, Brandon Myers-absent. Nays none. Motion carried.

Discussion on security equipment, procedures, signage, parking and public announcements.

George Lewis stated he reviewed the occupancy and square footage of the Courthouse and that the plans presented to him would meet fire code. There needs to be 44 inches of clearance from the doors so the seats along the east wall will need to be moved.

The Board of Commissioners approved the contract with a secure courthouse start date of June 4, 2018. Committee members will be present to work with guards. Committee will place signs on doors and notices in the Telegraph to notify the public. Payroll clocks on the North and South side will need to be moved to allow employees to clock in/out and not get congested at the South entrance.

Motor Vehicles lines will need to be assessed as the direction will change.

County Attorney would like a key lock placed on their interior door. Boyer and Jeff Higgins will visit with County attorney's office as to possibly restructuring their foyer to accommodate staff meeting with members of the public in a more secure environment.

Rolland and Jerome will get prices for lockers that the public can use for small items in the event they forget and bring restricted items in with them. The lockers will be placed in the foyer and be a key lock system. Public will be responsible for any items placed in the lockers.

The construction of the sidewalk will begin this week.

Walk through scanner was approved for purchase at the March 26 Commissioners meeting.

Security Procedures have been reviewed by Joe Wright and sent to officials. Roland Kramer moved to recommend Security Procedures to the County Board for approval. Boyer seconded the motion. Roll Call Vote: Jerome Kramer-absent, Bill Henry-aye, Tammy White-aye, Julie Stenger-absent,

Les Green-aye, Booker Boyer-aye, Michelle Gurciullo-absent, Roland Kramer-aye, Brandon Myers-absent. Nays none. Motion carried.
