

Security Committee  
June 12, 2018

The meeting of the Security Committee was held on June 12, 2018 at 9:00 a.m. in the Commissioner's Room.

Jerome Kramer called the meeting to order at 9:00 AM. Present were Jerome Kramer, Rolland Kramer, Bill Henry, Brandon Myers, Tammy White, Booker Boyer, Julie Stenger and Michelle Gurciullo. Absent was Les Green. Guests present were Jeff Higgins, Dave Pate, Angie Forbes, and Lois Block.

Kramer announced the Open Meeting Act with amendments is posted for public review and the Security Committee will comply with the open meeting requirements.

Rolland Kramer moved to approve the order of the Agenda. Myers seconded. Roll Call Vote: Jerome Kramer-aye, Bill Henry-aye, Tammy White-aye, Julie Stenger-aye, Les Green-absent, Booker Boyer-aye, Michelle Gurciullo-aye, Roland Kramer-aye, Brandon Myers-aye. Nays none. Motion carried.

Henry moved to approve the minutes of May 30, 2018 meeting. Boyer seconded. Roll call vote: Jerome Kramer-aye, Bill Henry-aye, Tammy White-aye, Julie Stenger-aye, Les Green-absent, Booker Boyer-aye, Michelle Gurciullo-aye, Roland Kramer-aye, Brandon Myers-aye. Nays none. Motion carried.

Review of security implementation.

The first week of guards on duty went well as reported by committee members who were present. The number of people that entered the courthouse was more than estimated and flow was steady. People didn't have to wait in line.

G4S reported: FOR THE WEEK OF 6-4 TO 6-8, G4S ADMITTED 2926 persons through security. 258 knives were checked at the entrance point. 20 positive reports with 8 negative comments.

Security Committee would like to recommend to Board of Commissioners to change procedures to add State Probation officers be allowed to bypass security. Copies of the State ID's have been given to the G4S guards. Belts will not be removed; people with belts will be wanded. There needs to be more signage on the East End about the Emergency Exit Only. Boyer will get a sign made for the East End.

Gurciullo stated that they have been asked about the glass at motor vehicle. The employees would like to keep it but remove the speaker covers. She will discuss with Sue Fleck and have Sue let building and grounds know what they want to do.

Parking-Green absent so no report on when parking stalls will be updated. Committee asks employees to not park on the South side.

Henry moved to recommend to the Board of Commissioners to Amend the Security Procedures to include adding State Probation officers to those allowed to bypass security with proper identification but will be also subjected to random inspections similar to employees. Boyer seconded the motion. Roll call vote: Jerome Kramer-aye, Bill Henry-aye, Tammy White-aye, Julie Stenger-aye, Les Green-absent,

Booker Boyer-aye, Michelle Gurciullo-aye, Roland Kramer-aye, Brandon Myers-aye. Nays none. Motion carried.

Lois Block stated she received a letter from Judy Clark regarding meetings after 5:00 p.m. Committee stated procedures will not change for meetings after 5:00 p.m. when guards are not on duty. If Judy or anybody else in charge of meetings would like security for the meetings, they are to contact dispatch and request officer on duty to attend the meeting.

Kramer set the next meeting on July 10, 2018 at 9:00 a.m. to be in the Training Room at the Detention Center.

Stenger moved to adjourn the meeting at 10:00 a.m. Rolland Kramer seconded the motion. Roll call vote: Jerome Kramer-aye, Bill Henry-aye, Tammy White-aye, Julie Stenger-aye, Les Green-absent, Booker Boyer-aye, Michelle Gurciullo-aye, Roland Kramer-aye, Brandon Myers-aye. Nays none. Motion carried.
