Security Procedures will be delivered to offices this week. Employees need to review them.

Courthouse will implement security on June 4, 2018. Security Committee members will be present at 7:30 a.m. when the doors are unlocked. There will be a run through after the security meeting. Signage will be in place by Friday. Parking-officials are once again asked to request employees park in other designated areas rather than around the courthouse and to save those for members of the visiting public. City has been sent a letter to request the change of the handicap parking. Public announcements have been made.

Review of incidents-Kerry Sides mentioned an incident in County Court where a defendant followed an employee into the locked area. Nothing happened and he was asked to step outside the locked area in

which he complied. Committee states this is one of the reasons why everyone is using the South doors to prevent members of the public following in employees.

Chawnta Durham asked questions of committee as it related to allowing in maise for her own protection as she meets with defendants behind closed doors. She also asked about her concern on making it to court on time if the Judges called her to come immediately and not wanting to cut in line to get through the line to get in.

Committee stated that anything that is not allowed into the Courthouse is according to State Statute. Committee members have talked with Judges and assume there will be an allowance for time and employees are allowed to bypass security once their ID is shown. The officer will become familiar with employees and the time will be minimal to enter the courthouse.

Henry set the next meeting on June 12, 2018 at 9:00 a.m.
