The meeting of the Security Committee was held on July 10, 2018 at 9:00 a.m. in the Commissioner's Room.

Kramer announced the Open Meeting Act with amendments is posted for public review and the Security Committee will comply with the open meeting requirements.

Henry moved to approve the order of the Agenda. Stenger seconded. Roll Call Vote: Jerome Kramer-aye, Bill Henry-aye, Tammy White-aye, Julie Stenger-aye, Les Green-aye, Booker Boyer-absent, Darla Morris-aye, Roland Kramer-absent, Brandon Myers-aye. Nays none. Motion carried.

White discussed wandering by the guards. She has had several people report that guards are not wandering when the metal detector is alarmed. Committee discussed the necessity of wandering and do not want the guards to become complacent. White will email G4S Secure Solutions, Randall Vonk and talk to the guards about the Committees requests.

An incident was reported of the South Door not closing all the way once it was locked and opened Friday night after business hours. Sheriff's Department contacted dispatch and officers secured the courthouse. Building & Grounds will check each door before they leave for the night and call Control at the Sheriff's Department to alarm the doors.

Discussion on parking-City has marked the stalls. Employees are still parking on the South Side after being asked not to via email and the newsletter. The Committee believes that employees working 8:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m. Monday-Friday are employees of the County and not members of the public and should not utilize parking by the Courthouse that should be used by customers of the Courthouse. Enforcement will be increased.

Discussion on the East Doors Emergency Exit. People are exiting through the doors even after the Caution tape was placed on the doors. Discussion on the statute allowing them to be cited. Discussion on changing the signage to state Violators will be arrested or prosecuted.

Myers and Jerome will check into the statute.

Committee discussed everyone should be using the South doors.
