Kyle with G4S states that Adams County now has everyone including employees go through scanner. The decision was made after the tragic incident in North Carolina. They also do not allow liquids.

Committee discussed the last year of security. Committee expressed frustration with accountability and inconsistency of staff placement. Would request G4S to reiterate to guards about not becoming complacent. Security Committee is concerned guards are not scanning everyone, asking for employee ID's and allowing non ID'd individuals to bypass through security.

Committee agreed that there will need to be more discussion regarding belts, pacemakers and everyone going through security.
