"Shall Logan County School District 0501 (Stapleton Public Schools) in the State of Nebraska issue its bonds in a total principal amount not to exceed \$2,900,000 for the purposes of financing the costs of constructing certain additions to and improvements of the District's existing school building, including a music room, locker rooms, office space, an entry and restroom improvements, and acquiring and installing certain equipment, furniture and apparatus for such additions and building; said bonds to be issued from time to time, to be sold at such prices, to bear interest at such rates, to become due at such times, and to have such other terms and provisions, all as may be fixed and determined by the Board of Education of the District; and "Shall the District cause to be levied and collected annually a special levy of taxes against all the taxable property in the District sufficient in rate and amount to pay the principal of, the premium, if any, and the interest on said bonds as the same become due?"

CITY OF NORTH PLATTE ISSUE #1
"Shall the City of North Platte establish an Economic Development Program (North Platte Quality Growth Fund) as described in its adopted Economic Development Plan by appropriating annually from local sources of revenue up to \$650,000.00 for 10 years?"

CITY OF NORTH PLATTE ISSUE #2
Shall the City of North Platte allocate, from its existing Local Option Revenue Act sales tax, the sum of up to \$650,000 per year for 10 years, to fund the North Platte Community Economic Development Program (North Platte Quality Growth Fund), subject to the following limitations:

NO (Against the Program)

a) for that part of the City's 2020-2021 fiscal year from April 1, 2021 to September 30, 2021, the Economic Development Program shall receive 50% of all sales tax receipts over and above \$3,714,868 prorated monthly. For the City's first full fiscal year thereafter, the Economic Development Program shall receive 50% of all sales tax receipts over and above the annual base amount of \$7,578,330;

A. The goals of the program shall be to create new employment opportunities at above average wages and benefits, encourage the attraction of new business and industry, diversify the local economic base, broaden the local tax base, support the retention and expansion of the existing business and industry base, create new job opportunities for local residents and the region's young people, foster capital investment in the region and improve the quality of life for the City of North Platte and surrounding areas.

b) for each full fiscal year thereafter, the base amount shall be increased by 2% over the previous fiscal year's base amount, with the Economic Development Program to receive 50% of all sales tax receipts over and above the base amount as so increased;

B. Funds for the program may be used for the following purposes: public works improvements; job credits, investment credits, direct loans and grants for fixed assets and working capital, options and purchase of real estate and personal property, business park development, technical assistance, recruitment, marketing and promotional expenses, relocation expenses, workforce housing programs, loan guarantees, job training assistance, building construction and rehabilitation, whether or not the business is identified at the time, purchase of Community Redevelopment Revenue Bonds, payments to private and public entities to support development of a business, contracting for administration of the economic development program, issuance of bonds, and as otherwise established by Nebraska law. Any modifications of the Local Option Municipal Economic Development Act by the state legislature shall automatically be incorporated into the local plan.

c) for the fiscal year in which the funding for the Economic Development Program ends, on March 31, 2031, the base amount for that fiscal year shall be prorated on a monthly basis, with the Economic Development Program to receive 50% of all sales tax receipts over and above the prorated base amount;

C. The Program shall commence April 1, 2021 and end March 31, 2031, a ten (10) year period.

d) funding for this Economic Development Program shall begin on April 1, 2021, and shall end on March 31, 2031.

D. Collection of funds shall begin April 1, 2021 and end March 31, 2031.

A vote for this measure will result in the continued re-allocation of a portion of the existing sales tax funds for the Economic Development Program (to fund the North Platte Quality Growth Fund).

E. The source from which funds are to be collected shall be a portion of the existing 1.5% City Local Option Sales Tax.

A vote against this measure will not result in the continued re-allocation of a portion of the existing sales tax funds for the Economic Development Program.

F. The total amount to be collected from the local sources of revenue for the Economic Development Program will be up to \$6,500,000.00 over a 10-year period, or \$650,000.00 annually.
